

Worship Buddies

If you attended the Quarterly Meeting last month, you might've heard Pastor Ramiro mention our hope for helping kids stay engaged in worship. For families who have multiple children attending church on Sunday mornings, staying calm and focused in worship can be extremely difficult. We would like to offer families the choice of having an adult Worship Buddy sit with their child during the service and help keep them interested and engaged in worship. We are creating a "pool" of volunteer Worship Buddies who are available to sit with



kids during the service as needed. We don't plan for Worship Buddies to be used for first time visitors and guests who are not actively involved in our church family. The nursery will remain open and available for all kiddos who have not yet entered Kindergarten.
