

Spring Together

God's unmerited, undeserved, unending love for us is a good way to define the word grace. We United Methodist believe that while God can zap us with a powerful dose of grace anytime God chooses, grace tends to be perceived most often when we intentionally partake in what John Wesley called the means of grace. The means of grace are things we can do that tend to help us experience God's grace. The means of grace are spiritual disciplines, and include: worship, service, receiving Holy Communion, fasting, and prayer. We want to specifically focus on one of the means of grace during different times of the year, and this winter/spring we invite all of the good people who worship here to focus on prayer.

A number of you have already begun doing this. The 30 Days with Wesley prayer book we handed out is helping some of us focus on prayer in a new way. To build on this, we are hosting an event centered on prayer on Saturday, May 2. During this event, we will begin the process of creating prayer blankets. We will cut out blankets from material the church is supplying and will pray as we tie knots in each corner. The rest of the knots will be tied by the 5th graders of Binion Elementary as part of a service project. These blankets will then be distributed to the residents of Brookdale.

Beside the prayer blankets, we will also have prayer stations set up and will have people who will pray with anyone who desires prayer. We will also have a panel discussing prayer, and other explore how we can become an even more prayerful congregation!

An Egg-ceptional Opportunity to Help

It is almost Easter time and we NEED EGGS!

Well, we need EGG CARTONS!

Here's an egg-ceptional opportunity for the congregation during April and May. The McCurdy Mission Team is collecting "EMPTY" egg cartons (those that hold only one dozen eggs). We need enough egg cartons to hold 25 dozen eggs for 52 weeks! **That's 1,300 egg cartons.** Why, you ask? It's a great story. One of the great blessings of the annual trip to McCurdy is the renewing of our special relationship with the members of Santa Cruz UMC in Espanola, New Mexico. That small church (membership 37) is located across the street from the McCurdy Ministries campus. The work team always worships there on our first Sunday of the trip (more than doubling their average Sunday attendance) and they always treat us to a lovely lunch where we enjoy catching up with our old friends. On Tuesday of our trip week a few of our team again visits Santa Cruz to help with their "feeding ministry". (Here's where you and the egg cartons come in.) Volunteers from the church go to the local food bank weekly to secure food for about 25 people. These are folks in the community who need some help. Some don't drive; some are ill; some are permanently at-home; some are caring for family members; all need help accessing enough food. The Santa Cruz folks pack the boxes and distribute or deliver the food each and every week. Two years ago we discovered that eggs were one of the food items not provided by the food bank, so we supplied them. Last year we repeated our gift. We also discovered that by buying in bulk we could save money but we needed egg cartons to put them in. This year we have asked for a grant from the Mission Team to cover the cost of the eggs. We just need the cartons to put them in. **Here's where our CPUMC congregation can help!** We need 1,300 **empty** egg cartons (**one dozen size**). Throughout April and May we will collect and store and then transport them to Santa Cruz in June. (Please leave them in the containers in Reeves Hall and in the containers by the Mission Room. Our sisters and brothers in Christ at Santa Cruz UMC are truly the hands and feet of Christ. We have an egg-ceptional opportunity to serve along side them. Please help in any way that you can.
