LYDIA TAYLOR

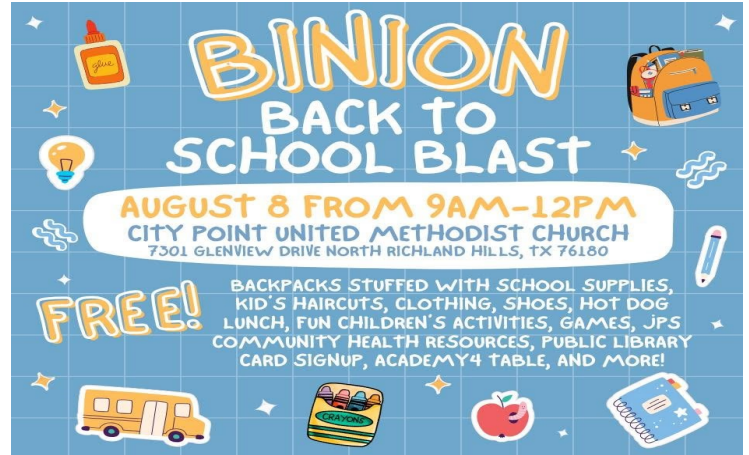
