

We wanted to share with you something Anne wrote years ago when answering the questions "My Story, How I was blessed to be a blessing". We pray you enjoy Anne's words.



Presented programs and hosted the group in my home. Through membership int his group I became active in other areas of church work.

I passed on God's Blessing and became a Blessing... Today W.S. C. is United Methodist Women and now United Women of Faith and have been blessed by this group for many years.
