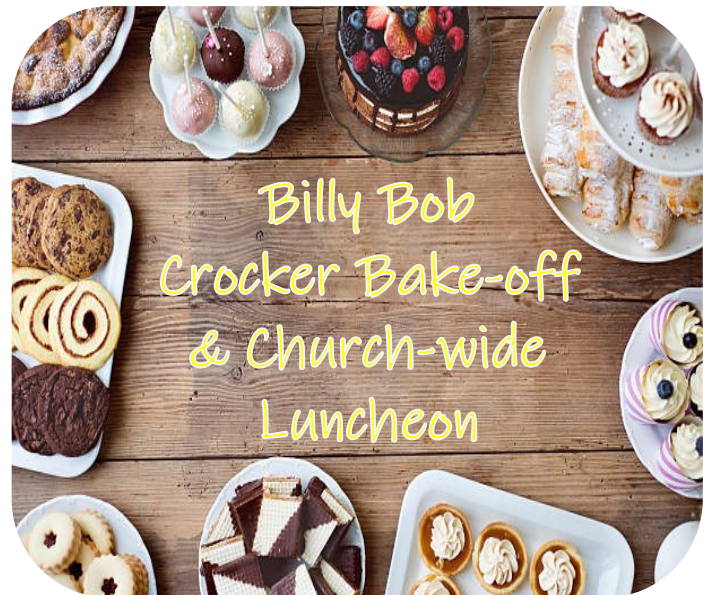

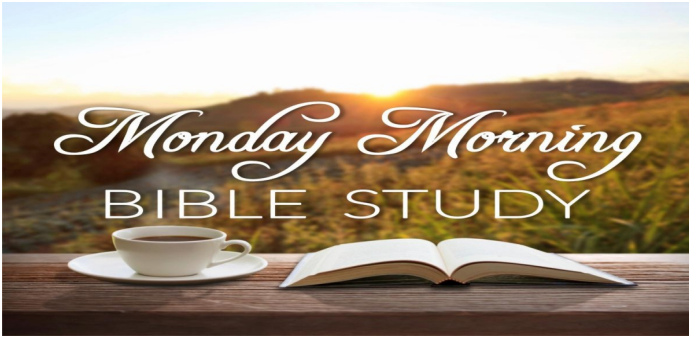

We wanted to share with you something Anne wrote years ago when answering the questions "My Story, How I was blessed to be a blessing". We pray you enjoy Anne's words.

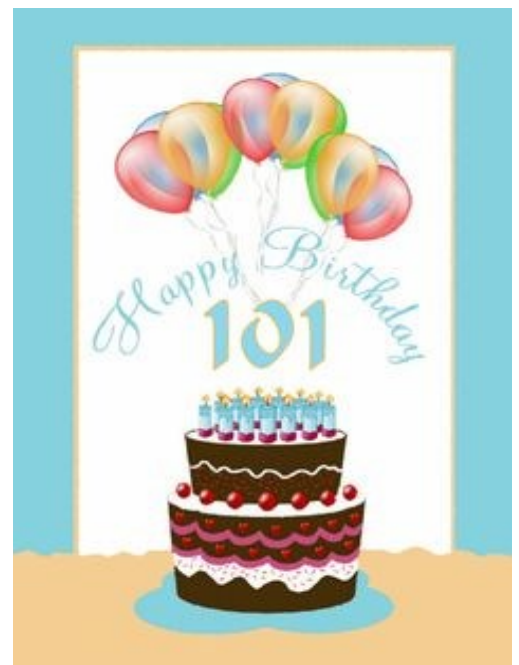

Christian Service. Jimmie Eddleman invited me to the meetings and came and picked me up. The women I met in that group are still some of my best friends.

***I made God's Blessing a part of my life...*** I stayed in the group until 1959 when my first child was born and I quit working. I served as present of W.S.G. and held many other offices. Presented programs and hosted the group in my home. Through membership into his group I became active in other areas of church work.

***I passed on God's Blessing and became a Blessing...*** Today W.S. C. is United Methodist Women and now United Women of Faith and have been blessed by this group for many years. 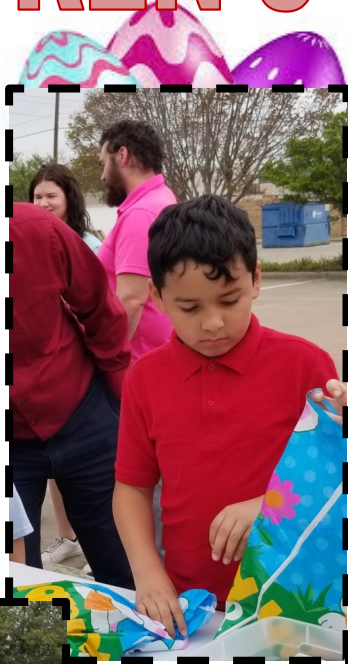
